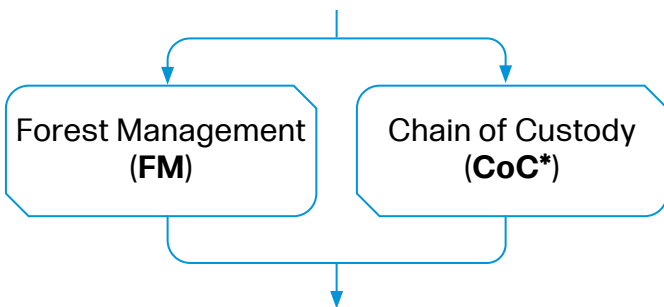

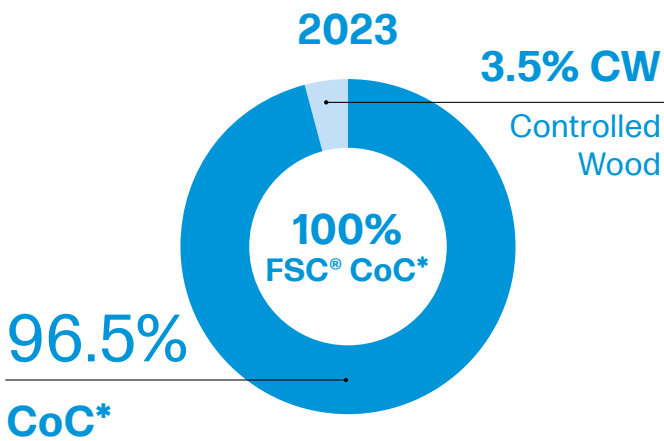
What does it mean to be FSC® certified?

The FSC® label identifies products containing **wood from forests fairly and reliably managed** according to FSC standards covering **environmental, social and economic aspects**.

The FSC® framework is divided into the following levels of certification



100% of our paper mills are managed under FSC® CoC certification and in 2023 96.5% of the pulp purchased was FSC® certified and 3.5% **FSC® Controlled Wood**.

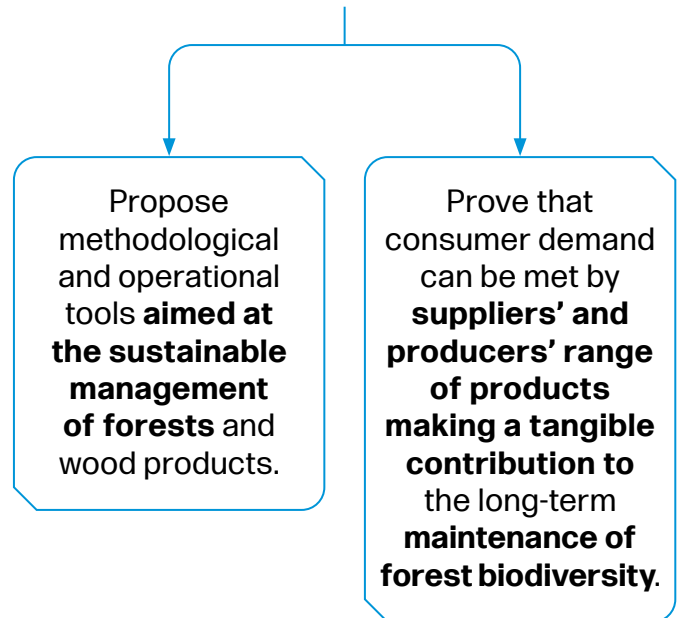


***Ensures the traceability of materials** from responsible managed forests, controlled sources, recovered materials or a combination of these sources. **It facilitates the transparent flow** of goods made from such materials through the supply chain and is essential for applying FSC® labels on products.
