Seiri (Sort)

Eliminating from the workplace items not needed and finding a place for items that are needed.

Seiton

(Set in order)

Seiso (Shine)

Check and maintain tidiness and cleanliness.

Seiketsu

(Standardize)
Maintain the first
three pillars,
ensuring them
to be upheld.
